McGraw moved and McGeehan seconded approval of the consent agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Jones went through the announcements and said he had an additional announcement that he will be leaving the City of Moscow. He has accepted a position in Utah. The Board thanked Jones for his work and said he was a true asset to Moscow and the region. There was some discussion.

Jones said he put together a schedule of meetings which he displayed. He said the committees will meet at noon.

5. Economic Indicators (national, regional, local) – Jeff Jones

Jones discussed what is involved when calculating economic indicators. He displayed maps to show the progression of states moving from recession to recovering or growing over the last several years. He went through unemployment rate statistics for cities in the area as well as Latah County which is currently 6%. He explained what is involved with figuring out the economic health of an area. He listed various cities' MSA rankings and McrSAs rankings and discussed employment growth in the area for 2012-2013. He showed a graph predicting future trends. There was discussion.

- 6. Legacy Crossing Update Jeff Jones
 - o EPA Assessment /Cleanup Grant Work Plan 6th and Jackson
 - ✓ Draft Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP) Application

ACTION: Authorize the Chairman to execute the Voluntary Remediation Agreement between the Agency and IDEQ, and direct Staff to prepare a check in the amount of \$2,500 as required by the Agreement.

Jones said there is an agreement for the Board's consideration to enter into the Voluntary Cleanup Program. It will require a \$2,500 check. The Agency's attorney has reviewed the contract. He discussed the benefits of the program and financing. Weber moved and Sullivan seconded to authorize the Chairman to execute the Voluntary Remediation Agreement between the Agency and IDEQ, and direct Staff to prepare a check in the amount of \$2,500 as required by the Agreement. McGraw asked what the \$2,500 buys. Jones said it is to have IDEQ review the older studies that were done, what has been done to date and determine what else needs to be included. IDEQ thinks there are some data gaps. This will help the Agency get through the process as quick as possible and then staff can determine what else needs to be added to the work plan. He said it will be necessary to market the property and there may be additional costs with the development of the work plan. There was some discussion about IDEQ, how much the total cost of this part of the process will be and what affect it might have on a future owner. Motion carried unanimously.

Market Absorption RFP

Jones said he is in the process of preparing the market absorption RFP. The entire market will be examined as well as the specific area we are interested in.

There was some discussion about the Anderson project.
